Student Transportation

Students are registered on a specific bus by the Transportation Department of Northern Gateway Public Schools. They are not able to ride alternate buses. Students also should not get off at a stop that is different than the one assigned to them. Transportation is only provided from home to school and from school to home. A student may get off the bus at another stop IF the parent is there to facilitate the change. If you have any questions about this policy, please contact the school office.



Attendance

Attendance is taken at 9:05 am each day. If you know your child will be away for an activity or appointment, please write a note in the agenda or email the classroom teacher. If your child is ill, please phone the office in the morning, prior to 9:00 am. Our phone system is equipped with an answering machine should you wish to phone before 8:00 am. This contact will enable us to account for the whereabouts of all students. Please do not use Remind to send a notification of a student absence. If a teacher marks a student absent, and we have not been informed, our SchoolConnects automated phone system will place a call home to the primary home phone number at 9:30 am.

Attendance Monitoring

Regular attendance at school is essential for student achievement and success. When students miss a great deal of school, teachers are not able to reteach concepts missed and therefore students may fall behind. Students may miss other activities in order to get caught up if they are missing class on a consistent basis. WCS monitors student attendance and will contact families when concerns arise.
