*If you are unable to attend the day you are scheduled to volunteer, please contact your child's teacher.

Questions/Communication

Teachers will review the prepared activities when you arrive at school. If you have any questions, please ask. They will be glad to assist you.

Process

When you arrive at the school, please sign in at the office and collect a volunteer lanyard.

Other Information

*We ask that volunteers respect our FOIP guidelines and not take pictures or videos of any students while you are at school.

*Modeling good digital citizenship behaviour is important when volunteering at the school.

*If you see a conflict between any students, please speak with a school staff member.

*Students are encouraged to take risks and make mistakes in order to learn. Our classrooms are "mistake friendly" areas where we promote responsibility and respect.

*Younger children who come with parents will need to remain with parents as to not disturb the learning environment of the school.
