### School Supplies

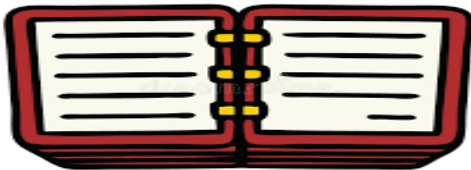

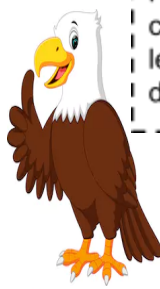
### Contact Information and Field Trips
